- The Division has 800 registered Online learners at this time.
- The government has supplemented the budget 3.45 million dollars. Highlighted areas of spending are:
 - o \$2 000,000 has been budgeted to at home learning support.
 - \$1500 a day for cleaning high touch areas in the school/classroom.
 - \$500,000 in Covid related supplies.
- All school international trips have been cancelled for the year.
- A survey has been sent out to parents regarding the selection of the new superintendent.
