Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to École Our Lady of the Rosary School. At ÉOLRS our vision is Learning, Listening and Following Jesus and we look forward to providing catholic education to your child(ren) and working in team with you to provide a safe and caring learning environment. As a staff we focus on Knowing, Understanding and Responding to our Learners in order to provide them with the best education possible. Below you will find some helpful information regarding start up for next school year. We are so honoured you chose to join our school community and wish you and your family a blessed summer filled with fun, and relaxation.

Here is some information regarding next year. We begin morning supervision at 8:09 a.m. with the entry bell going at 8:15 a.m. You can find the [bell schedule](#) on our [website](#).

We have staggered recess times. Kindergarten English, Grade Two and Grade Four students have recess at the same time. Kindergarten French, Grade One and Grade Three students share recess times. Staggered recesses allow for more playground access for students and staff have noticed this practice has been a huge success and benefit to student self-regulation and play.

We asked families for feedback about staggered entry. The question was posed as we know from previous experience that having smaller classes to start the first couple days of school assists in positive student mental health with a decrease in anxiety by having smaller classes and allows for teachers to more quickly build relationships with students, and the importance of these relationships in a trauma informed approach. We requested feedback from families as we know staggered entry can affect childcare and families' schedules. Based on our survey data to the question; Would you be in favour of staggered entry for the first two days of school moving forward? 56% of respondents reported yes, 29% responded no, and 15% reported no opinion. Based on the majority of respondents reporting yes we will begin with staggered entry next year.

Staggered Entry for Grades One to Four will occur on September 1 and September 2. On Thursday September 1 students with last names beginning with A-L will attend school. Students with the last names beginning with M-Z will attend their first day of school on Friday, September 2. We coordinated the last name staggered entry dates with École Mother Teresa School so that families from both schools will attend on the same day. All students will attend class on Tuesday, September 6, after the long weekend. This staggered entry structure will not impact Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten as they have a separate staggered entry schedule that will be communicated to families.

As we begin the new school year we are excited to welcome families to our Meet the Staff on Wednesday August 31 from 8:30 a.m. - 9:30 a.m. This practice allows families to drop off school supplies and allows your children to meet their teacher and find their classroom prior to the first day of school. This practice has been well attended and received in the past as it assists in relieving student anxiety by meeting their teacher and identifying the location of their classroom.
