Highlights

We are proud that École Our Lady of the Rosary School has continued to rank above the provincial averages in all Assurance Measures categories. Specific areas of celebration include:

- 93% of our stakeholders recognize the high quality educational experience we provide for both our English and French Immersion students through the collective efforts of our staff and partners.
- Our focus on knowing, understanding, and responding to both the academic and social emotional needs of our students has placed us 8% above the provincial average in providing a welcoming, caring, and safe learning environment.
- 93% of teachers, parents and students are satisfied that our students model active citizenship through caring for others, doing their best, and being involved in community activities.

Targeted Areas

Create opportunities for staff to nurture their own faith and collaborate on how best to nurture the faith of their students through professional development with the support of our faith team.

Empower teachers through bi-weekly collaboration meetings to set goals for new curriculum implementation with a focus on innovation, engagement, and evidence-based teaching practices.

Provide targeted intervention particularly in the area of literacy. Our LIFT teachers and Inclusive Learning Lead ensure at risk students receive targeted support based on literacy screens.

- Our faith priority is to nurture the faith of our students and staff in ways that are authentic and personally meaningful to all students and staff.
- Our priority for student learning is to foster teacher efficacy as we continue with the implementation of new curriculum through enhancing collective leadership structures within our school.
